TOWN of FOX LAKE Monthly Board Meeting Minutes

Monday, December 8th, 2025 — Town Hall at 7:00pm

Chairman Kok called the regular monthly meeting to order at 7:00PM with 7 members of the public and 5 Board members present ... The Pledge of Allegiance was performed at the beginning of the meeting.

Chairman Kok announced the upcoming meetings: Fox Lake Fire Association: Tuesday, January 13, 2026, at 7:00 P.M, Randolph Fire Assoc. Meeting: Wednesday, January 14, 2026, at 7:00 P.M. The next regular monthly Town Board meeting will be on Monday, March 9, 2026, at 7:00 P.M, Supervisor Brieman made a motion to accept the meeting minutes for the 10th monthly meeting. The motion was seconded by Supervisor Grams, and the motion was carried.

Clerk/Treasurer Wojciechowski provided the following summary for the Board members and public present for November 2025. Regular checking Account had a beginning balance in the amount of \$140,399.85, with a transfer from the Tax Savings Account in the amount of \$0 with receipts and interest in the amount of \$100,667.71, and disbursements in the amount of \$40,688.17 for an end balance of \$200,379.39.

The Local Government Investment Pool Account had a beginning balance of \$242,680.20, with receipts and interest in the amount of \$802.69 with an end balance of \$243,482.89.

The Tax Savings Account had a beginning balance of \$6,768.23 With receipts-interest \$.00 and Tax Payments in the amount of \$0 transfer to general check in the amount of \$0, with an end balance of \$6,768.23.

The Municipal Court Savings account had a beginning balance of \$11,516.24, with receipts from interest, fines, and assessments in the amount of \$124.00 and transfers to New General Checking in the amount of \$0 with an end balance of \$11,640.24.

The Boat Launch Savings Account had a beginning balance of \$10,410.15, with receipts and interest in the amount of \$.00 with an end balance of \$10,410.15.

The Money Market Account had a beginning balance of \$168,833.38, with interest in the amount of \$270.60 for an end balance of \$169,103.98.

Total of all accounts of \$641,784.88. A motion was made by Supervisor Grams to accept the Treasurer's Report, seconded by supervisor Brieman, and the motion was carried.

**Committee Reports:**

Police: Officer Gebhardt reported there was 3 complaints, 1 citations, 0 Warnings, and 3 assist from EMS and local agencies. Total hours worked 28.00

**Governmental Relations:**

The Board was informed that the group which performed the plant study on Lake Emily has not responded back so the DNR will step in and help.

**Roads:**

Supervisor Grams: presented a spread sheet containing Pass Rating and estimated total cost of roads, along with the condition of each road and plans for repairs.

Supervisor Eisenga spoke to brushing on several roads.

**Waste Disposal & Recycling:**

Supervisor Brieman made note that the new Garbage collections calendar was sent out along with the property tax bills.

**Parks & Lakes:**

Supervisor Drews informed the board that the new credit card machine for the Town Park boat landing would be ordered in 2 weeks. It was also noted that the FLPO will provide the installation of Lake Signs.

Chairman Kok informed the board that the FLPO will contribute \$5000.00 toward the installation and removal of Bouy's on Fox Lake.

It was also discussed assessing the Property owners or asking for additional funds from the City to help with that expense.

Chairman Kok recommended looking at what the cost would be to repair Aerators on Lake Emily.
